Former St Margaret's Home Trustees Preset Donation to NHS Comfort Funds

A donation has been made from the former St Margaret's Care Home, the SEC residential care home that sadly closed in early 2024. The winding up of the affairs of the SEC charity that ran home is now almost complete, and as part of this the trustees of the home wished to make a donation towards the care of residential and palliative care patients in Dundee.

The bishop attended and presented a cheque for £6,500 to representatives of NHS Tayside, Roxburghe House and the Royal Victoria care units. These funds will be used by NHS Tayside for comfort and support of patients and residents.

St Margaret's Home closed due to financial pressures in early 2024, bringing to an end about 150 years of SEC involvement in care provision in the city of Dundee.

Faith in Community Dundee: Welcome Pack Appeal for Asylum Seekers (Closing date 15 August)

From FiCD Dundee: We have recently been made aware of a specific need in our city and are looking for some help from local faith communities.

In Dundee there is an accommodation provider which houses approximately 120 single male asylum seekers. More often than not, these men arrive with no belongings. A very practical resource to provide on their arrival, is a small welcome bag, containing some basic items. We are reaching out to church

communities to help us to gather a stock of items, over a set period of time, to bolster the stocks for these welcome bags. The items we are looking for are:

Anti-bacterial spray Sponges for washing up

Toilet rolls Paper and pens

Washing up liquid

Collection Point: We are partnering with Maxwell Centre (St Salvador's Halls, Dundee, DD3 7EW) who have agreed to act as a collection point for all donations. The centre is open at the following days/times:

Mon -Thur – 9.30am –5pm & Friday 9.30am-4pm

We would be really grateful if you were able to gather any donations of the above items and then drop them to the Maxwell Centre, where there will be a collection point for the Welcome Pack Appeal.
