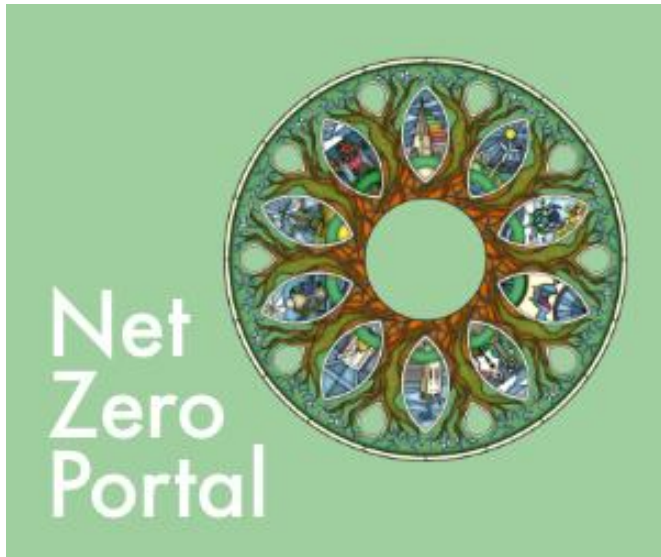

MOTHERS UNION at 150

Mothers Union has just one branch in Brechin Diocese and this is St Mary's Broughty Ferry. Christine Berry attended the special celebratory service at St Paul's Cathedral, London, in June, which was led by the Archbishop of Canterbury, Sarah Mulally. The following day there was a gathering of over 600 members saluting the history of MU, its important work in the past and its current projects. Back home in Broughty Ferry a fund raising strawberry tea was held later in June.

August 9th is known as Mary Sumner Day by MU members remembering the birthday of the founder 150 years ago. Churches throughout Britain and Ireland were encouraged to be involved in a "take over" day, and at St Mary's the banner was processed, members acted as welcomers, read the lessons and gave the intercessions. The rector an MU member himself, gave an appropriate sermon. At the end of the service a

quarter acre of Woodland at Moncrieff Hill was dedicated by the joint dioceses of St Andrews Dunkeld and Dunblane and Brechin in celebration of 150 years of Mothers Union. We then adjourned for coffee and a piece of celebratory cake decorated with the MU logo.
