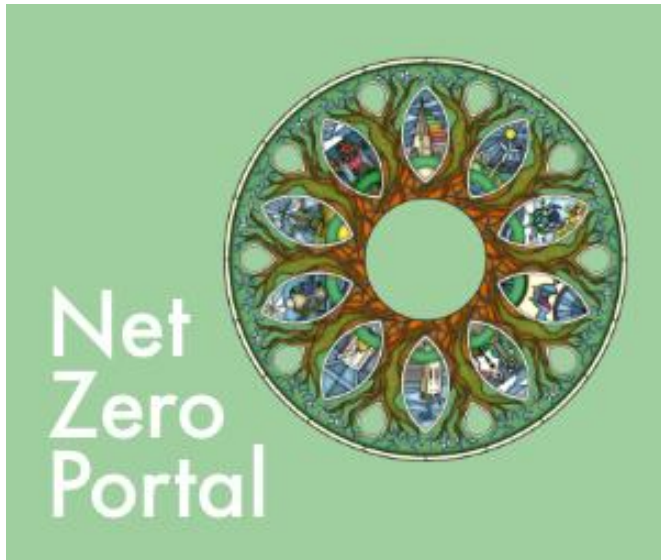

So what is the Communion Forest? It is an environmental initiative of the Anglican Communion launched at the Lambeth Conference in 2022. It encourages local activities of forest protection, tree growing and eco system restoration by provinces, dioceses, and individual churches across the Anglican Communion. The fifth mark of mission of the Anglican Church is to safeguard the integrity of creation and to sustain and renew earth.

In our diocese we have already dedicated quite a number of trees mainly in the Woodland Trust land at Backmuir Wood near Liff.

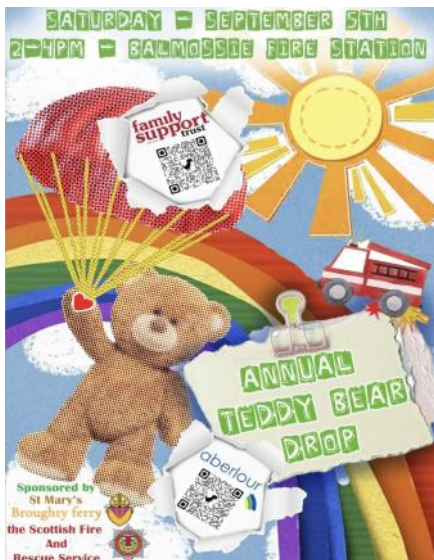
